KYCTA Charter

Draft charter was discussed, updated and unanimously agreed upon.

Explanation of words / response to questions:

- Extension: to spread Kundalini Yoga in Cambodia
- Professional training both in English and Khmer. Documents to be in both English and Khmer
- KYTCA is not only for English speaker but in particular for Cambodians – Khmer speakers
- KYCTA teacher support:
 - Organize Teacher Training: Basic Teacher Training, Level 1 and 2, Radiant Child and other professional trainings
 - Teacher Biography with photo: outline a standard template. Teachers to write biography and this will be posted on the Kundalini Yoga Cambodia website
- KYCTA is a non-profit association. There are businesses involved. Persons are members on personal title, not as representative of a Business.

Members

The meeting agreed to the following membership categories:

- Certified Kundalini Yoga Teachers (all levels including Basic Teacher Training)
- Teachers in training and practitioners in Cambodia interested to start Teacher Training
- Those interested in supporting the extension and application of the Kundalini Yoga teachings in Cambodia.

Membership fee

The meeting agreed to an annual membership fee of \$30 for international members and \$10 for Cambodians. Cambodians who have difficulty to pay the fee amount and want to be member can do seva for KYCTA.

KYCTA will issue membership cards, and will give teaching references.

- 10% of the annual KYCTA member fund will be transferred to the International Kundalini Yoga Teacher Association (KYCTA) in the USA.
